

# Ambroxol HCI

## Zobrixol®

30mg Tablet 30mg/5mL DS (Syrup) 15mg/5mL (Syrup) 6mg/mL (Syrup Oral Drops) **Mucolytic** 

Description of the Product Ambroxol HCI (Zobrixol) 30mg tablet is white to off-white, round, plain on both side

Ambroxol HCI (Zobrixol) 30mg/5mL DS (Syrup) is colorless to yellowish syrup with

raspberry/peppermint flavor. Ambroxol HCI (Zobrixol) 15mg/5mL (Syrup) is colorless syrup with raspberry alcoholic

Ambroxol HCl (Zobrixol) Fingolite (Gydp) is colorless sydp with rasporty alcohol typical odor and sweet taste.

Ambroxol HCl (Zobrixol) 6mg/ml (Syrup Oral drops) is colorless to yellowish syrup with raspberry/peppermint flavor.

What is in the Medicine?
This medicine contains Ambroxol, which stimulates respiratory fluid secretion, resulting to a less sticky mucus. Ambroxol makes the mucus/ phlegm easier to cough out and breathing is eased considerably.

What is this Medicine used for?
This medicine is used for the relief of cough caused by acute and chronic disorder of the respiratory tract accompanied with thick and sticky mucus such as acute and chronic bronchitis, asthmatoid bronchitis and bronchial asthma.

### How much and how often should you use this Medicine?

Tablet (30mg) Children 6-12 yrs:  $\frac{1}{2}$  tablet 2-3 times daily Adults & children over 12 years: 1 tablet thrice a day for the first 2-3 days and then 1 tab twice daily or  $\frac{1}{2}$  tablet thrice daily.

Double Strength (DS) syrup (30mg/5mL)
Children 6-12 years: 2.5mL 2-3 times a day.
Adults & children over 12 years: 5mL thrice a day for 2-3 days, then 5mL twice daily or 2.5mL thrice a day.

Syrup (15mg/5mL)
Children under 2 years: 2.5mL twice a day
Children 2-5 years: 2.5mL thrice a day
Children 6-12 years: 5mL 2-3 times a day
Adults & children over 12 years: 10mL thrice daily during the first 2-3 days, then 10mL twic daily or 5mL thrice daily.

Syrup Oral drops (6mg/mL) Children 6 months and under: 0.5mL twice a day Children 7-12 months: 1mL twice a day Children 13-24 months: 1.25mL twice a day

When should you not take this Medicine? If you are allergic to any component in the product.

Care that should be taken when taking this Medicine? Do not take more than the recommended dose.
Consult a physician if any adverse effect occurs.
Not recommended during the first three month of pregnancy. Do not use after expiry date.

Undesirable Effects of this Medicine
Ambroxol is generally well tolerated. Gastro-intestinal disturbances nausea, vomiting), transient rise in serum aminotransferase. In rare cases wheadache and skin rash.

What other Medicine or food should be avoided while taking this Medicine? Ambroxol HCI (Zobrixol) should not be taken simultaneously with antitussive (e.g codeine), because it could lead to non-expectoration of phlegm or mucus previously liquified by Zobrixol.

What should you do if you miss a dose?
If you miss a dose, just take the dose if still needed and subsequent doses at the usual recommended schedule. Do not exceed recommended dose.

Signs and Symptoms of Overdose
Symptoms of Ambroxol overdose include extension of undesirable effects such as
Gastro-intestinal disturbances (diarrhea, nausea, vomiting) and skin rashes.

# What to do when you have taken more than the recommended dosage? If you have taken more than the recommended dosage, consult a physician.

How should you keep this Medicine? Store at temperatures not exceeding  $30^{\circ}\text{C}$ . Keep out of reach of children to the control of the con When should you consult your doctor?
If symptoms persist and if any undesirable effects occur
